


Figure 2: Graph from *UNCTAD*, shows the percentage of active online shoppers conducing at least one online purchase every 2 months.

Unemployment rate (%)




Figure 3.3: Graph from *Pew Research Center* showing the following one in four young adult workers that are unemployed because of the pandemic.
